If you wish to pay in USD, you must submit a letter stating this.*

Sibling/Family/Corporate Discounts

For any families applying for 2 or more children **at the same time**, a maximum Application Fee of \$300 will be charged per family, and a reduced Development Fee of \$1,500 per child will apply. A 10% sibling discount on Tuition Fees will be applicable for each additional sibling from the same family concurrently enrolled in the school. Corporate discounts of up to 15% per child are applicable for companies/families with more than 5 children concurrently enrolled at any given time.

School Uniform, School Bus and School Canteen

The Latham School uniforms are available at *Toto Junction*. All pupils must wear the approved school and PE kit when at school. Uniform costs will be additional to those listed above. Uniforms must be purchased at the uniform shop and are not available in school. Costs indicated below in TZS are indicative and may vary.

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The Latham School offers the option of additional services for the convenience of families, including school transport and canteen. These optional services are offered by external providers, and parents may choose to use them at their own discretion and risk. Payment for these services is to be made directly to the providers, and prices shown are indicative only. Parents who wish to use these services can request more information and forms from the school office.

Swimming @ The Latham School

Swimming is an integral part of the curriculum at The Latham School. Every child must learn to swim and must purchase the correct attire and equipment. Timetabled swimming is at no additional cost. We also offer the option of being a part of the Tanzania Swimming Club (at Bahari) or the Dar Swim Club (at Masaki) after school hours, with whom we hold strong partnerships. Membership in these clubs is optional, and fees are payable directly to the respective swim club. Should a child want to enrol, then she/he must either be off the school site at the close of the academic day, or pay for supervision – until the scheduled training session starts.

Explanation of Various Fees

Application Fee

A non-refundable fee is payable at the time of submitting a written application for the child's admission. Applications will not be processed until application fees have been received and cleared.

Good Faith Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of 10% of the annual tuition fee is payable in advance **after** the child has been assessed and been offered admission to the school, in order to reserve the child's place. Once the child has been enrolled in school, this deposit will be applied towards payment of the fees, which become due before the child starts school. This is **NOT** an additional fee to those stated.

Development Fee

A Development Fee is payable once, on enrolment, for all new entrants to the school from Year 1 upwards. Parents may request to pay this in 2 instalments. The Development Fee is a contribution towards the development of school facilities, IT infrastructure and resource development. Once paid, this fee is non-refundable.

Field Trip Fee

The field trip fee covers the transport and basic meal costs of participation in curriculum-related day trips (1 per term) for all classes each year. For children in Years 1-9, the Education Beyond Boundaries week (usually scheduled in June each year) is also covered. In addition, for children in Years 5-9, this fee includes 1 overnight trip (between 2-3 nights). In the event that international destinations are planned, parents will be informed in advance and may be required to top this up. Spending money and travel/health insurance are not included and will be charged extra. This fee is not optional and is non-refundable in the event that children do not participate in the field trips, or if trips do not take place for unforeseeable reasons.

Annual Tuition Fees

Annual tuition fees include tuition, textbooks and teaching materials but do NOT include external examination fees. For all external examinations, a CAIE examination fee as well as administration fees will be charged. Fee will be published prior to entry for external examinations. Examination fees will be charged separately for *Checkpoint* examinations.

Re-enrolment Deposit

A non-refundable re-enrolment deposit of \$350 for each child is payable each year before the end of the 2nd term to reserve a child's place in the school for the next academic year. The deposit is credited to the first term's fees due for the following academic year and is **NOT** an additional fee to the fees stated. Returning children who do not complete the re-enrollment process within the deadlines each year **will have to pay penalties and re-apply** for their place in the school. They may find themselves on a waiting list if classes are over-subscribed.

Late Fees

For any fees (or part thereof) unpaid at their due dates, a late fee of \$50 per week (or part of the week thereof) will be applied without exception.

Damage to School Property

On occasion, children may damage or lose school library or textbooks issued to them, or cause damage to school property. In such instances, parents will be informed and expected to cover the cost of damage or replacement.

Non-inclusive Costs

For all extra-curricular activities which *are offered by external coaches or after the end of the school day*, there will be additional costs that parents will be required to cover. On occasion, classes will be taken on *additional* curriculum-related field trips. These may be day trips, overnight trips, or trips extending to a few days in addition to those covered in the scheduled field trips. For children selected to participate in school teams, additional costs of appropriate sport kit and transport will be charged separately. Parents are expected to cover all additional costs related to these trips, which are not included in the fee schedule.

Additional Support

The Latham School is committed to ensuring all pupils have an education that meets their needs. Where a pupil requires additional educational support beyond what would ordinarily be expected to be provided in a mainstream class, arrangements may be made after full consultation with the school and parents. Actual costs will depend on the type of support required, and the demand for this kind of support.
